

國立東華大學人文社會科學學院楊牧文學研究中心設置及管理要點

NATIONAL DONG HWA UNIVERSITY College of Humanities and Social Sciences Guidelines for the Establishment and Management of the Yang Mu Center for Literary Studies

(Implemented June 5, 2019.)

一、國立東華大學（以下簡稱本校）榮譽教授王靖獻博士（筆名楊牧），以比較詩學研究斐聲國際學界，其文學創作亦臻一代經典地位，「楊牧學」業已成為海內外學術研究重要的主題。為推闡楊牧文學研究，爰於人文社會科學學院（以下簡稱本院）設立「楊牧文學研究中心」（以下簡稱本中心），並擬定「國立東華大學人文社會科學學院楊牧文學研究中心設置要點」（以下簡稱本要點）。

I. National Dong Hwa University (hereinafter referred to as NDHU) Honorary Professor Wang Ching-hsien (pen name "Yang Mu") is internationally acclaimed for his work in poetry studies and literary creations. "Yang Mu studies" has become an important topic in academia both at home and overseas. The NDHU has therefore established the Yang Mu Center for Literary Studies (hereinafter, the YMCLS) under the College of Humanities and Social Sciences (hereinafter, the College) and drafted the National Dong Hwa University College of Humanities and Social Sciences Guidelines for the Establishment and Management of the Yang Mu Center for Literary Studies (hereinafter, the Guidelines) to promote the studies of Yang Mu's literary works.

二、本中心主要工作項目如下：

- (一) 蒐集、統合相關研究資源，建立楊牧文學資料庫。
- (二) 推動楊牧文學研究之國際學術交流與合作。
- (三) 辦理國際學術研討會，編輯出版相關論文集。
- (四) 協助青年學者從事相關領域之博士後研究。
- (五) 規劃相關課程並提供教學上所需之資源。
- (六) 楊牧書房之管理及經營。
- (七) 辦理相關文學活動。
- (八) 其他與本中心相關業務。

II. The main responsibilities of the YMCLS are:

- A. The collection and integration of study resources for the establishment of the Yang Mu literature database.
- B. The promotion of international academic exchange and collaboration on the literary study

of Yang Mu's works.

- C. The organization of international academic seminars and the editing and publishing of the relevant proceedings.
- D. The assistance of young academics with postdoctoral studies in related fields.
- E. The planning of relevant courses and provision of necessary academic resources.
- F. The management and operation of the Yang Mu Library.
- G. The organization of relevant literary activities.
- H. Other miscellaneous affairs pertaining to YMCLS

三、本中心經費以自籌為原則，來源如下：

- (一) 申請政府與民間研究計畫或產學合作計畫。
- (二) 接受捐贈。
- (三) 諮詢服務收益。
- (四) 其他收入。

III. The YMCLS shall be self-funded in principal; the sources of funding being:

- A. Public/private research projects or industry-academia collaboration projects
- B. Donations
- C. Consultation service revenue
- D. Other income

四、本中心組織架構如下：

- (一) 設主任一人，由實際參與本中心之研究，且為本校專任助理教授（含）以上之教師兼任，綜理中心業務。
- (二) 中心主任由楊牧文學講座執行小組向本院院長推薦，並簽請校長遴聘之。任期三年，得連任。中心主任任期屆滿前，由本院院長諮詢相關人員並確認現任主管意願，決定是否連任，主任連任免重新簽請校長遴聘，由學院逕予製發聘函。
- (三) 得設專案人員若干名，協助主任處理中心各項業務。

IV. The organizational structure of the YMCLS

- A. The YMCLS director is responsible for the overall management of YMCLS affairs and is held by NDHU faculty members at the rank of full-time assistant professor and above, who participate in the academic studies conducted by the YMCLS.
- B. Candidates for the position of YMCLS director are recommended by the Yang Mu Literary Seminar Task Force to the dean of the College, who in turn submits potential candidates to the president for appointment. The tenure of the position is a three-year renewable term. The dean of the College shall consult the current director prior to the end of his/her tenure and decide if he/she would be reappointed, noting his/her wishes. Reappointment of YMCLS director and the issuance of the Certificate of Appointment by the College do not require authorization from the president.

C. Several contracted staff members are appointed to assist the director in handling various YMCLS affairs.

五、本中心管理機制如下：

- (一) 依本校相關規定接受中心評鑑。
- (二) 每學年至少召開一次中心會議，規劃及檢討中心運作。
- (三) 每二年提出業務報告（格式依本院規範）送院備查。

V. The administrative mechanisms of the YMCLS are:

- A. The evaluation of the YMCLS in accordance with NDHU regulations.
- B. The holding of at least one YMCLS meeting each semester to review and plan for future YMCLS operations.
- C. The biennial submission of business reports to the College (in the format stipulated by the College).
